



## ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE

Re: Safety Measures on Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ Lands

Enacted under the Emergency Preparedness Act  
section 3.4


### BACKGROUND:

- A. Effective May 28, 2020, pursuant to section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the President extended the state of emergency declared on March 30, 2020 on all Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ lands because of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; and
- B. Section 3.4 of the Emergency Preparedness Act provides that while a Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ emergency declaration is in effect, the Executive may do all acts and implement all procedures that it considers necessary or advisable to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency, health hazard or disaster.

### NOW THEREFORE THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Effective as of the date of this Order and in accordance with section 3.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, **ALL PERSONS** on Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ lands must adhere to and abide by the most current orders, directives, protocols and guidelines issued by the Province of British Columbia or British Columbia's Centre for Disease Control with respect to COVID 19 response measures.
- 2) Failure to comply with this Order is an offence under section 4.2 of the Emergency Preparedness Act and any person committing an offence is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months.
- 3) The Order of the Executive YFNO 29/2020 made May 21, 2020 is hereby terminated and ceases to have force and effect as of the date of this Order when effective.
- 4) This Order continues until the later of the following dates:
  - a. the date on which the emergency declaration made March 30, 2020 under section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act expires or is cancelled, or
  - b. if there is an extension of the emergency declaration under section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the date on which the last extension of that declaration expires or is cancelled.
