



ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE

Re: Appointment of CARE Network Staff as Enforcement Officers

Enacted under the Enforcement Act section 3.1

YFNO 17/2018


BACKGROUND:

- A. On February 20, 2018, the CARE Network and the Yuułu?i?ath Government entered into the CARE Network Animal Control and Care Service Agreement (the “Agreement”) for the use of the CARE Network to provide animal control services for the Yuułu?i?ath Government;
- B. In accordance with section 3.2 of the Agreement, the CARE Network has agreed to enforce Yuułu?i?ath enactments, relevant to animal control; and
- C. Section 3.1 of the Enforcement Act authorizes the Executive, by Order, to appoint enforcement officers to enforce one or more Yuułu?i?ath enactments and preserve and maintain public peace.

NOW THEREFORE THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) In this Order,
 - a) “CARE Network” means the Coastal Animal Rescue and Education Network;
 - b) “CARE Network Staff Member” means any individual employed by the CARE Network who has successfully completed, at a minimum, the Bylaw Compliance, Enforcement & Investigative Skills 1 Course at the Justice Institute of British Columbia, or an equivalent course at another accredited institution.
- 2) Effective as of the date of this Order and for so long as the Agreement and any renewals are in effect, each CARE Network Staff Member is appointed as an enforcement officer under section 3.1 of the Enforcement Act with authority to enforce section 2.2 and Part 6 of the Public Order, Peace and Safety Act and the Animal Control Regulation.
