

ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

Re: State of Emergency on Yuulu?il?ath Lands

Enacted under the Emergency Preparedness Act section 2.4(a)

YFNO 42/2020

BACKGROUND:

- A. Because of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, on March 30, 2020, pursuant to section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the President declared a state of emergency on all Yuulu?il?ath lands which was extended on April 9, 16, 23, 30, May 7, May 14, May 21, May 28, June 4, June 11, June 18, June 25, July 2, July 9, and July 16, 2020; and
- B. The continuing risk of an outbreak of COVID-19 among the public remains a health hazard under the Emergency Preparedness Act.

NOW THEREFORE THE PRESIDENT ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Effective as of the date of this Order and pursuant to section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act, the President declares that a state of local emergency continues on all Yuulu?il?ath lands;
- 2) The Executive's authority under section 3.4 of the Emergency Preparedness Act to implement response measures continues;
- 3) The authority of the director of operations and the director of lands and resources to perform their duties and exercise their powers under sections 2.5 and 2.6 of the Emergency Preparedness Act, respectively, is continued;
- 4) Without limiting the directives issued in this Order, the Executive may at any time during the local state of emergency enable additional response measures in accordance with the Emergency Preparedness Act; and
- 5) This Order expires on July 30, 2020 and is subject to revision, cancellation or extension by the President in accordance with section 2.4(a) of the Emergency Preparedness Act.
