PART 1 - INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Short title

1.1 This regulation may be cited as the Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation.

Application

- 1.2 This regulation prescribes
 - (a) the form for a compliance notice,
 - (b) the form for a ticket,
 - (c) the forms for applying for review of a compliance notice or ticket under section 6.1 of the Act,
 - (d) the form for a directive by the director of operations under section 6.1(e) of the Act,
 - (e) the manner in which enforcement forms must be completed,
 - (f) ticketable offences,
 - (g) for the purposes of section 5.2 of the Act,
 - (i) the particulars of the offence, and
 - (ii) the penalty, discounted penalty and surcharge penalty,

in relation to each ticketable offence,

- (h) the fee for applying for review of a compliance notice or ticket under section 6.1 of the Act, and
- (i) how an application for review form must be filed.

Definitions

1.3 In this regulation,

"Act" means the Enforcement Act;

"application for review form" means the form prescribed under section 2.1(d);

"enforcement form" means a form established under this regulation and includes any attachments to the enforcement form;

"ticketable offence" means an offence for which a ticket may be issued.

PART 2 - FORMS

Prescribed forms

- **2.1** (a) The enforcement forms numbered EA-1 to EA-7 are prescribed for the purposes of the Act.
 - (b) A compliance notice must be in Form EA-1.
 - (c) A ticket must be in Form EA-2.
 - (d) An application for review of a compliance notice or ticket under section 6.1 of the Act must be in Form EA-3.
 - (e) Nothing may be attached to an application for review form except
 - (i) one or more additional information pages in Form EA-4,
 - (ii) one or more schedules in Form EA-5, or
 - (iii) one or more affidavits in Form EA-6.
 - (f) A directive by the director of operations under section 6.1(e) of the Act must be in Form EA-7.

Completion of forms

- 2.2 (a) Every enforcement form must be completed and executed in accordance with
 - (i) the Act,
 - (ii) this regulation, and
 - (iii) the instructions on the enforcement form, as applicable.
 - (b) Every enforcement form, including attachments, must be on durable paper of 27.9 cm x 21.5 cm in size.
 - (c) An enforcement form must be completed by printing or typing in
 - (i) legible characters of 10 or 12 pitch, but not smaller than 12 point, and
 - (ii) black or dark ink that is compatible for electronic scanning, optical character recognition or micrographic technology of the kind used in the Yuulu?il?ath administration office.

(d) An attachment to an application for review form that is an affidavit in Form EA-6 must be sworn on oath or affirmation before a lawyer, notary public or other person authorized by the Evidence Act (British Columbia) to take affidavits for use in British Columbia.

Abbreviations

2.3 An abbreviation of any word on an enforcement form must not be used unless the abbreviation does not obscure the meaning, intent or legal effect of the application form.

English language

2.4 Every enforcement form must be completed in the English language.

When failure to use prescribed form does not invalidate proceeding

2.5 If a ticket or compliance notice is not issued in the prescribed form, a proceeding or an action in relation to the compliance notice or ticket, as applicable, is not invalidated if the form used is substantially similar to the prescribed form and meets the other requirements of the Act.

Multiple offences

2.6 An enforcement officer may issue a single ticket for more than one contravention of a Yuulu?il?ath enactment.

PART 3 - TICKETABLE OFFENCES

Ticketable offences

- 3.1 (a) Each contravention of a Yuulu?il?ath enactment listed in Column A of Schedule 2 is a ticketable offence.
 - (b) For each ticketable offence,
 - (i) Column B of Schedule 2 sets out the particulars of the offence for the purposes of section 5.2(a) of the Act,
 - (ii) Column C of Schedule 2 prescribes the penalty for the purposes of section 5.2(b) of the Act,
 - (iii) Column D of Schedule 2 prescribes the discounted penalty for the purposes of section 5.2(b) of the Act, and
 - (iv) Column E of Schedule 2 prescribes the surcharge penalty for the purposes of section 5.2(b) of the Act.

Repeal

- 3.2 (a) The Building Forms Regulation YFNR 16/2013 is amended by repealing section 4.2 and Schedule 3.
 - (b) The Animal Control Regulation YFNR 33/2016 is amended by repealing section 3.2 and Schedule 3.

PART 4 - REVIEW OF COMPLIANCE NOTICE OR TICKET

Application fee

- 4.1 (a) A person applying for review of a compliance notice or ticket under section 6.1 of the Act must pay an application fee of \$25 to the Yuulu?ił?ath First Nation.
 - (b) The application fee payable under subsection (a)
 - (i) must accompany the application for review form,
 - (ii) must be paid
 - (A) by cash,
 - (B) by certified cheque or money order payable to the Yuulu?il?atḥ First Nation, or
 - (C) by such other form of payment as may be approved by the chief financial officer, and
 - (iii) is non-refundable.

Filing an application for review form

- 4.2 A person may file an application for review form with the director of operations
 - (a) in person,
 - (b) by mail, or
 - (c) by fax.


