

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PART 1 - INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Short title

1.1 This regulation may be cited as the Ticket Form Amending Regulation.

Application

1.2 This regulation makes an amendment to the Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation.

Definitions

1.3 In this regulation,

“Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation” means the Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation YFNR 42/2017.

PART 2 - REGULATION AMENDMENTS

Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation amendments

- 2.1 The Compliance Notice and Ticket Regulation is amended by repealing Form EA-2 set out in Schedule 1 and replacing it with Appendix "A" to this regulation.

PART 3 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Commencement

3.1 This regulation comes into force on the date it is enacted.
