Do Not Consume Notice Still in Effect

GENERAL UPDATE

As of 5:45pm on January 25, 2022, the District of Ucluelet and hita?u completed restoration of the water lines! The Do Not Consume Notice is still in effect; residents may return to use of normal running water for general hygienic and laundering purposes. The next step is ensuring the water is safe for consumption by testing samples. We thank the District of Ucluelet and most importantly the Public Works Team for working hard towards restoration for the health and safety of hita?u citizens. **Yuufu?if?ath Government has not issued a Boil Water Advisory, please do not consume boiled water.**

WATER USE & RESTRICTIONS

Residents of hita?u may move to using water for:

-  Showers, except for infants and toddlers
-  Hand washing
-  Washing dishes
-  Laundry
-  Flushing toilets
-  Remember - ***Do not consume the water***
