



## Yuułuꞑiꞑath Government Oath of Office

June 14, 2020

**June 13, 2022 - Jay Millar was sworn in as the ha'wiih Representative.**

*“Each person who is elected or appointed the Legislature to serve the Yuułuꞑiꞑath must swear or affirm to perform his or her responsibilities appropriately answering the questions, which will be asked by the Tye Ha'wilth or other person delegated by the Legislature.”*

At the Legislature Meeting dated June 13, 2022, Elder Bob Mundy assisted the Director of Operations in administering the Oath of Office, in accordance with sections 2.1(d) and (e) of the Government Act, was appointed and presented officially swearing in Jay Millar as the ha'wiih Representative.

The appointment of a hereditary chief to the Legislature is made by the ha'wiih Advisory Council (the “Council”). Per the Yuułuꞑiꞑath Constitution:

- ☉ Section 2.11: *an advisory body composed of the Yuułuꞑiꞑath ha'wiih (the Yuułuꞑiꞑath hereditary chiefs) is established with the name ha'wiih Advisory Council.*
- ☉ Section 2.13: *The legislature must consult with and seek the advice of the ha'wiih Advisory Council in relation to Yuułuꞑiꞑath culture and traditional values, Yuułuꞑiꞑath customary laws and matters relating to this Constitution in accordance with the rules of procedure for the Legislature.*

It is acknowledged that Wilson Jack remains as the respected, Tye ha'wilth, for Yuułuꞑiꞑath.

We congratulate Jay Millar for his role as the ha'wiih Representative, as a Member of Legislature for Yuułuꞑiꞑath.
