## West Coast Transit

### West Coast Transit has arrived!

**Starting Tuesday, April 2**, West Coast Transit will be offering services along the west coast, connecting the communities of hitaču, Ucluelet, and Tofino.

With this letter, you will find a West Coast Transit Riders Guide, which includes the transit schedule, pick up locations, and a 'how to' use the transit service. To kickstart the program, the Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ Government is offering citizens free tickets to utilize the transit service. Below are general questions you may have.

#### Who is eligible to receive tickets?

- You must be a **citizen** of Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ-Ucluelet First Nation to receive your ticket(s).

#### How many tickets can I have?

- Minimum of **one (1)** single ride ticket (one time use per ticket).
- Maximum of **two (2)** books containing 10 single ride tickets (one time use per ticket).

#### Where can I pick up tickets?

- Tickets can be picked up at Cixʷatin Centre Reception. Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 4:30pm, excluding holidays and weekends.
- Tickets are always available for purchase with West Coast Transit.

#### What happens if I lose my ticket book or individual ticket?

- All citizens are responsible for their tickets, lost or stolen books will not be replaced. Tickets are not for sale.

#### Where does the transit stop?

- Transit will **enter** the community with pick up/drop off at:  
(A) huuᓅatu Centre (B) Wya Rd. (C) Cixʷatin Centre
- Transit will **depart** the community with pick up/drop off at:  
(A) Cixʷatin Centre (B) Wya Rd. (C) huuᓅatu Centre

As this is a new program, the Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ Government in accordance with the ACRD, will monitor use of the transit system and demand of tickets, to better understand the needs of the community. Happy riding!
