Starting on Saturday, March 1, 2025, BC Transit will begin operating the West Coast Transit System that links hitaċu, Esowista, Ty-histanis, Tofino, Ucluelet, and Long Beach. The transition brings five new buses to the fleet and more drivers to increase the consistency of transit services.

New bus signs are being installed that feature nuučaanuł language provided by Yuułu?ił?atḥ Government and other partnered nations. This is the first time an Indigenous language has been incorporated into BC Transit signage.

All tickets purchased before the switch to BC Transit will be honored and Yuułu?ił?atḥ Government intends to continue providing free bus fares for Yuułu?ił?atḥ citizens. Further information will be provided at a later date.
