The Yuulu?il?ath Government invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified individuals, businesses, or organizations to bid on the harvest of Halibut and Salmon for the 2025 Domestic Food, Social, and Ceremonial (FSC) Fish Program. This program supports the sustainable and equitable harvest, processing, and distribution of fish for food, social, and ceremonial use within the Yuulu?il?ath community.

Contractor Responsibilities

- Submit bid pricing for each species listed below.
- All fishing must occur within the Maa-nulth Domestic Fishing Area.
- Fuel and ice costs are the sole responsibility of the Contractor and are not reimbursable.
- Offloads will take place in Ucluelet Inlet at Neptune Ice, unless an alternate site is agreed upon and included in the final contract.
- All contractors are expected to communicate clearly and in a timely manner regarding their departure times and offloading schedules.

Species Available for Bid

Note: Bycatch is to be included with the relevant primary species as indicated. Harvest quantities (*) are subject to change based on in-season assessments in accordance with the Maa-nulth Final Agreement. Preference will be given to Yuulu?il?atḥ citizens in the evaluation of submitted bids.
