TAKE NOTICE that the Yuulu?i?ath Government has enacted the Miscellaneous Amendments Act No. 3.

Brief Description

The Miscellaneous Amendments Act No. 3 (the “Act”) cleans up minor inconsistencies, outdated references, and technical issues across 16 Yuulu?i?ath laws. Most of the changes are minor and administrative, and help better align our legislation with current practice.

The more substantive amendments include:

- Transferring interim exclusion order powers to the Community Safety and Trespass Act and providing that exclusion orders may take effect immediately following a hearing;
- Updating public safety provisions related to disorderly conduct;
- Repealing outdated residential interest provisions in the Land Act that are no longer in use;
- Clarifying citizen engagement requirements for draft legislation to better reflect current engagement practices; and
- Expanding an existing exemption from Yuulu?i?ath land use and development laws so that Yuulu?i?ath institutions, including a future housing society, can advance housing projects more efficiently to support housing development.
