ʔuhʔaʕhasuu Citizens and Residents of hitaču,

We would like to inform the community of an important update regarding administration and coordination of Medical Patient Travel.

Effective immediately, all Patient Travel requests and related cheque processing will be managed through the **Department of ʔuuʕalukʷičʔaala (Health and Social Services)**. This change is intended to streamline services and improve coordination and support for citizens accessing care.

Susan Mundy is the main contact for Patient Travel services, including after-hours emergencies. She joined the department on **January 22, 2024**, and currently works in both Patient Travel and as a **Social Development Worker** and **Medical Office Assistant**, bringing experience from all of these roles to support the community.

What this means:

- All Patient Travel requests must now be submitted through the Health and Social Services Department.
- All cheques related to Patient Travel can now be picked up at the **huuʔatu Health Centre**.
- Health and Social Services staff will be available to assist with applications, questions, and follow-up.
