



Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ Government Temporary Water Disruption

January 27, 2026

ʔuḥʔaλḥasuu Citizens and Residents of hitaću,

Some hitaću residents have reported concerns with visual water quality in the affected area near the pump house construction site.

Water quality testing conducted on the weekend confirms that the water is safe for consumption, washing and cooking.

The attached photo shows the tested water (right) alongside an example of a failed test (left) for comparison. Please note that water colour alone does not necessarily indicate a failed test. Our team conducts water testing five times daily to ensure it is safe for consumption.

Please continue to cold flush the water if you notice any discoloration. Yuułuʔiłʔatḥ Government staff will continue to perform tests over the next few days. A notice is being delivered to affected homes.
